Committee Member update:

The GC welcomes Katrina as Family Liaison

Children play areas:

A sign will be put up reminding residents that the play area is for children under 12.

A sign with contact phone numbers in case of mishap will also be installed.

For insurance purposes, a weekly visual inspection of play areas needs to be carried out and logged.

The GC will investigate whether it can find space for a TRX workout support so that older children and adults can work out without using the children play area.

Garden update:

New lawn has now been laid down. Initial feedback from residents has been positive. The company has returned for an inspection and recommended that the GC wait until 19th of April before removing the protective fencing.

Lockdown Update:

Residents reported lockdown rules and byelaw breaches.

GC will continue to communicate on both fronts through welcome notes, signs and postings

GC will investigate the idea of bringing a guard for the summer weekends as was done last summer.
