Arundel & Elgin

1 - 2 Beds: Arundel at Kensington Park Road



1.

- Plant Japanese anemone x 6
- Luzula nivea x 5 (shade grass)
- Leucojum aestivum
- Ferns: Dryopteris linearis x 3
- Other fern x 3.
- Additional foxgloves in spring



2.

- Remove invasive bamboo & end of life plants
- Move in Tellima (fridgecup) from other bed
- Osmanthus x burkwoodii x 1
- Viburnum bukwoodii x1
- Japanese quince alba x 1
- Cornus Alba Sibirica (red)dogwood x 1
- Aquilegia



NEXT BED ALONG

- Persicaria x 3 between these 2 camellia
- Spring bulbs: narcissus and camassia

3 - 5. Arundel (in line with swings)



3.

- Remove ground cover

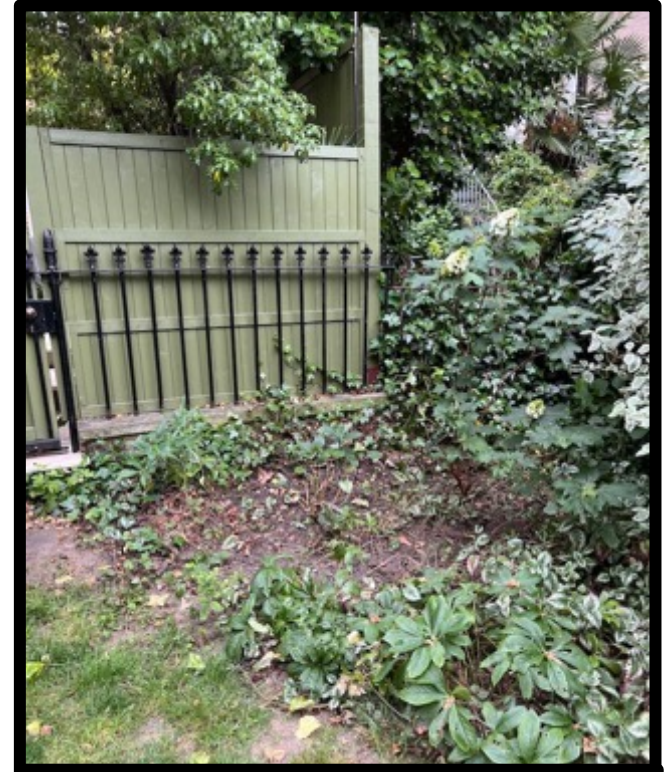
Plant:

- mahonia eurybracteata 'sweet winter' x 1
- Japanese Quince (white) nivalis alba x 1
- ferns metallicax 3



4.

- Remove one shrub (of 3)
- Forsythia x1
- Japanese quince red x 1
- Persicaria x 7
- Ferns



5.

- Move over hydrangea quercus

Plant:

- Philadelphus belle etoile x1
- Luzula nivea x 3
- Ferns x 3
- Camassia

6 - 7. Arundel



6.

LEFT OF MARKER

- Remove ivy smothering beds and spent shrubs
- Reduce bed border with new turf

Plant

- Plant Azalea Encore 'Pure White'
- Hellebores x5
- Luzula nivea x 5
- Camissia
- Fern x 3
- 2 types of Jap Anemone x 6 + 6



7.

- Remove bamboo and ground ivy. (leave on wall)
- Plant 3x Kerria Japonica 'pleniflora'
- Philadelphus belle etoile
- Geraniums

8. Arundel (both sides of the pittosporum)



Left of pittosporum

- Remove dying roses (wrong place)

Plant:

- Philadelphus belle etoile x 1
- Kerria plenti x 1
- Cenolophium denudatum (Baltic parsley) x 3



Right of pittosporum

- Remove all

Plant

- mahonia eurybracteata 'sweet winter' x 1
- Geranium psilostemon x1 (big)
- Cenolophium denudatum (Baltic parsley) x 2

10 - 11. Elgin at Ladbroke Grove



10.

- opposite playground/lilac - move Agapanthus due to extensive damage
- Plant Tenuifolium 'Tom Thumb' (purple & green) x 1
- Spring bulbs

11.

Keep the variegate pittosporum, rhododendron at the back and fatsia on right.

Plant:

- Tenuifolium Tom Thumb (purple & green)
- Pittosporum Tobira (Jap Mock Orange- scented bell flowers) x 1
- Deutzia setchuenensis 'Corymbiflora' x 1
- Luzuela nivea
- 6 Persicaria - Firetail (red h.1.2m)
- Blackfield (deep red h.1m & narrower)
- Superba (fluffy pink 0.6-0.9)



12. Elgin opposite the Mulberry



- Tweak: Move tall spires from front of bed.
- As ground elder successfully suppressed - take plants out of pots and replant. we had planted plants still in their pots until ground elder eradicated.
- Replenish Cosmos Bipinnatus 'Apricot Lemonade' (an annual) in front.
- This bed is the only one we grow annuals in. Not enough time in budget and slugs & snails love them

13. Elgin by a Lime tree

Reduce ceanothus & tree germander.

Remove dying mahonia

Plant: common tansy here

- Forsythia x1
- Malva × clementii Burgundy Wine x 1



14 - 15. Elgin opposite rhododendron & train hedge



14.

- Keep all. Shape. Remove salvia's, store and replant them in spring
- Plant:
- Grasses deschampsia x 3
 - Entrance edged with tulips
 - Re-turf bed edge next year when building works are done

15.

Remove woody, mildew vibernum.

- Russian sage
- Eryngium (blue thistle like) x3
- Patrinia punctiflora (yellow) x3
- Deschampsia x 3
- Rudbeckia x 6
- Turf where bed has been reduced



16 - 17. Train hedge, by greengage plum tree & corner



16.

- Leucojum aestivum (like snowdrops)
- Ferns: Athyrium 'Pewter Lace' x 3
- Euphorbia
- Bring in grass bed border definition
- Sunny corner: spring bulbs

KENSINGTON PARK ROAD
ENTRANCE CORNER

- Ferns: Ruby Buckler & Dryopteris
Lepidopoda x 7
- Hawera narcissus



17.

- Leucojum aestivum (like giant snowdrops)
- Replant Salvia from winter storage
- Fern Dryopteris lepidopoda x3
- Luzula nivea x 3
- Hawera narcissus to mirror adjacent corner



18. Train hedge/Horseshoe beds (Wildlife Area)/Roses



TRAIN HEDGE / ELGIN SIDE:

Cut pyracantha barrier to block footfall/trampling into Wildlife Area

- Molinia Arundinacea Windspiel (moor grass) x 2, to screen the barrier
- Deep pink Jap anemones *Anemone hupehensis* var. *japonica* 'Prinz Heinrich' x
- Rudbeckia x 6
- Euphorbia x merlot



ROSE CIRCLE

Reduce rose height further

- 12 x Salvia x Jamensis Nachtlinder (slugs ate half of them already)
- Astartia alba
- Geranium
- Tellima
- Mix of herbs



ARUNDEL SIDE:

Remove shrub due to slug/snail damage beyond recovery

- Tallima + Japanese Anemone
- Grevillea hedge to fill gaps by wisteria

19. Centre Garden



By the peonies / poppies:

Planted agapanthus moved from playground
Add allium & 3 more poppies



Planting still in works

- Verbena Bampton (purple) x 3
- Short alliums



Under heavily cut back white lilac.

- Virbernam opulus 'Roseum' shrub

20. Centre Garden



Elgin side:

- Geranium Psilostemon
- Phlox Paniculate Rembrandt x 5



By gate with purple rhododendron:

- Actaea 'Brunette' x 2
- Actaea 'Pritchards Gia' x 3
- Persicaria x 6
- Ferns 3 x Polystichen
 - 3 x Athyrium 'Pewter Lace'
 - 3 x Dryopteris rose buckler

by The Old Bench

- 1x exochorda 'The Bride' (early Spring)
- New David Austin Shrub Rose: 'Summer Song'

On the corner:

- Silver leaf senecio Angel Wings x 7: like any hosta, the slugs and snails love these

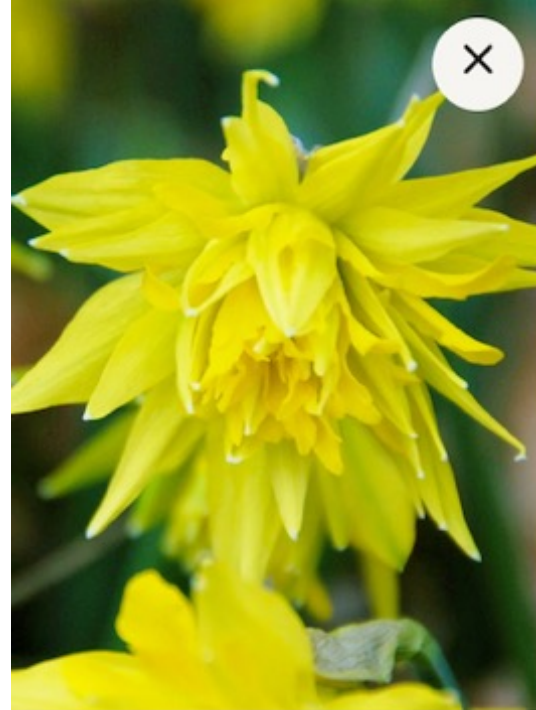

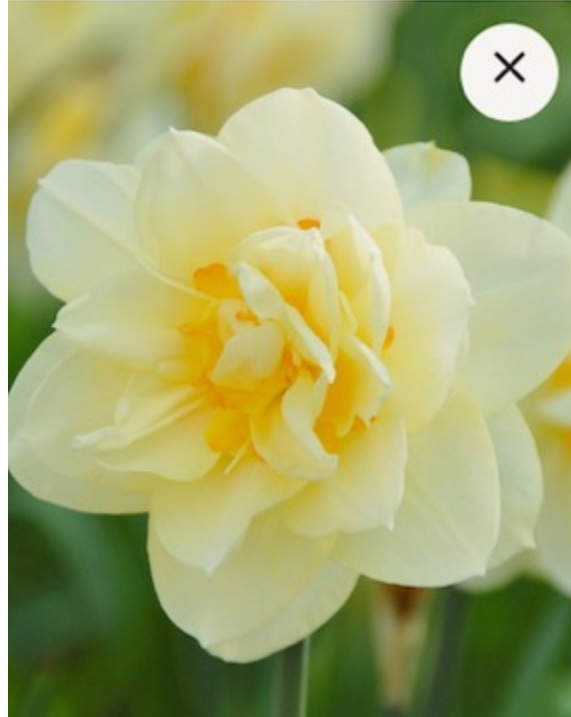

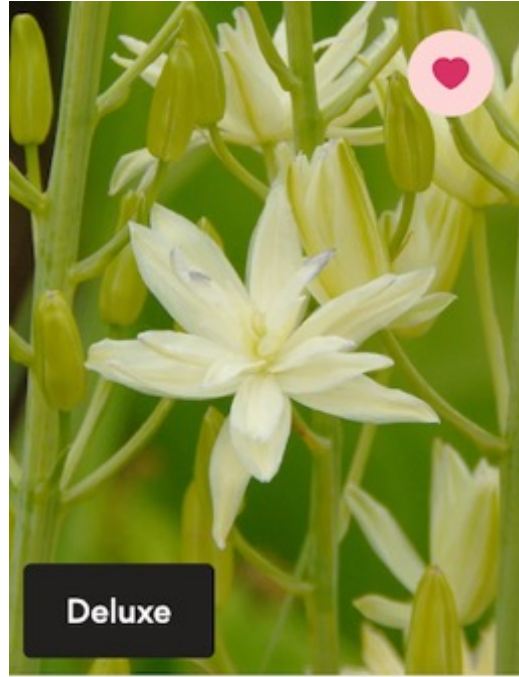
